



Notice to LLQP Students

As of January 1, 2016, the new harmonized LLQP provincial examination will be in effect. The previous LLQP examination (version prior to December 31, 2015) will be obsolete. **The Insurance Council of Manitoba will not host any further examination writes of the existing LLQP beyond December 23, 2015.**

With the new harmonized LLQP provincial examination, there are some notable changes as follows:

Rewrite Rules:

- Students can write the new exam 3 times before there is any waiting period.
- There will be a waiting period of 3 months after the third attempt (measured from the date of the 3rd attempt)
- There will be a waiting period of 3 months after the fourth attempt (measured from the date of the 4th attempt)
- There will be a waiting period of 6 months after any subsequent attempt (measured from the date of the latest attempt)

Marking of LLQP Examinations: Examinations can be marked in two different methods as follows:

<u>Compensatory Basis</u>	<u>Modular Basis</u>
<p>The exam modules are marked separately but the overall mark (minimum of 60% required) is based on the modules as a whole.</p> <p>Should the candidate fail on the <i>compensatory basis</i>, the candidate must re-write the entire exam (all modules) and successfully obtain a minimum of 60% in the overall examination in order to move forward with the licensing process.</p>	<p>The exam modules are marked individually and the candidate must obtain a minimum of 60% on each module.</p> <p>Should the candidate fail one or more modules in the <i>modular basis</i>, that/those individual module(s) must be re-written and the candidate must successfully complete each module with a minimum of 60% in order to move forward with the licensing process.</p>

Each LLQP examination applicant must provide a signed declaration advising which method of marking has been chosen. Once the method is chosen, it cannot be changed.
