On March 2, 2015 a letter from the Deputy Superintendent of Insurance was mailed to you regarding the transfer of the administration of hail agent and hail adjuster licenses to the Insurance Council of Manitoba (ICM).

The ICM is pleased to advise you that information which was previously on file with the Financial Institutions Regulations Branch has been received by the ICM and you may check your licence status through the Licence Search at [www.icm.mb.ca](http://www.icm.mb.ca).

On September 1, 2014 changes to *The Insurance Act* were proclaimed. There were no significant changes in the licence requirements for hail agents or hail adjusters other than an increase in the licence fees under the *Regulations* to ninety dollars per licence annually.

For your convenience you will now renew your licence using the on-line computer renewal system. This system has been used for several years in the issue and renewal of agent/adjuster licenses and has proven to be time effective and user friendly.
