



Agent Licence Renewal – Closed

You are receiving this email because you are listed with the Council as the primary authorized appointee (“Authorizer”).

The Insurance Council of Manitoba (ICM) agent licence renewal for the 2026-2027 period is now complete. Please review the list of licensees for the insurance company noted above by visiting the ICM website and using the [Licensee Search](#) and [Agency and Sponsor Search](#) tools to ensure all individuals are properly licensed with Council.

Any agent or broker who has not renewed their licence is considered unlicensed effective June 1, 2026. As such, they are not authorized to act as an insurance agent or broker, nor are they permitted to receive compensation for any new business written.

Applicants seeking licence reinstatement must complete an online reinstatement application. Instructions for this process are provided in the [User Guide - to Reinstate a Licence](#). Confirmation of reinstatement will be sent to the agent by email. ***Please note that any agent or broker with a gap in their licensing history must not act within the definition of an agent during the period in which they were unlicensed.***

As a reminder, you must notify ICM immediately if you no longer sponsor an insurance agent or broker (in accordance with Section 373(2) of *The Insurance Act* of Manitoba). To do so, log in to your [account](#), go to **Organizations**, select the applicable organization, and then choose **Licences - Manage Cancellation(s)**.

Please note that licensing status is updated regularly and may change daily. Current licence status can be verified at any time through the ICM website using the [Licensee Search](#) tool.
